The Legionary Must Pray as well as Work (Handbook Chapter 33 #12 pg 203)

In his allocution Fr. Soulliere spoke about the Spiritual Reading "The Legionary Must Pray as well as Work" taken from the Handbook Chapter 33 #12 Pg 203. Fr. Soulliere said:

Active members are urged to pray the entire Tessera although only the Catena, the second part of the Tessera is required of them. Auxiliary members must pray the entire Tessera, including the Holy Rosary (in the first part of the Tessera.) Active members should be an inspiration to the auxiliaries, thus they should equal the auxiliaries in prayer – and their recitation of the Holy Rosary would also make them especially pleasing to Our Blessed Mother.

We should remember that Our Lord has told us that the Father has given everything to Him, thus He not only keeps this universe going, but He provides for us and will someday judge us, thus even though our prayers and petitions are sometimes directed to a saint or and angel. We must implicitly remember him since he is the Chief mediator between us and the Father, and also Our Blessed Mother, since she is the Mediatrix of all Graces, we must work and pray. The spiritual reading ends by recommending that all should join the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary, whose privileges and benefits are described elsewhere in the Handbook.
